HOW TO APPLY?

Students who wish to benefit from Erasmus+ Study or Traineeship mobility must apply **online via the “TurnaPortal”** using their e-Government (e-Devlet) account.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

To apply for **Erasmus Student Mobility**, first-cycle students (associate and bachelor's degree) must have a **minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 2.20/4.00**, while second-cycle (master's) and third-cycle (doctoral) students must have a **minimum CGPA of 2.50/4.00**.

First-year students are **not eligible** to apply.

Applications will be evaluated over **100 points** based on:

- Academic Achievement: **50%**
- Foreign Language Proficiency: **50%**

Additional points and deductions will be applied in accordance with Erasmus+ implementation rules.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE EXAM

- **Written Exam:** 05 February 2026 (Thursday)
- **Oral Exam:** 06 February 2026 (Friday)

Details regarding the exam will be announced later.

The **minimum passing scores** for the English language exam to be administered by our University's **Department of Foreign Languages** have been determined as follows:

- **60/100** for departments where the **language of instruction is Turkish**,
- **70/100** for departments where the **language of instruction is English**.
(The exam consists of **80% written** and **20% oral** components.)

Candidates who score **at least 60** (for departments with Turkish as the language of instruction) or **at least 70** (for departments with English as the language of instruction) in the written exam will be invited to the **oral exam on Friday, 06 February 2026**.

Students who wish to use the exam results detailed below **instead of taking the English language exam**:

- **For undergraduate students:** ACUPEP/PPT exam administered by the School of Foreign Languages Preparatory Program within the **last two years** (minimum score: **70**)
- **For graduate students:** Exam administered by the Academic English Program in the **year they started their graduate program** (minimum score: **70**)
- Candidates who wish to **improve their scores** from the above exams may take the English language exam to be administered. In this case, **the most recent exam result will be considered valid**.

MOBILITY CONDITIONS

- **Study Mobility:** Minimum duration of **90 days** (bilateral agreement required)

- **Traineeship Mobility:** Minimum duration of **60 days** (no bilateral agreement required)

GRANTS & TRAVEL SUPPORT

Monthly grants and travel support will be provided in accordance with Erasmus+ country groups and distance calculator rules. Participation without a grant is also possible; non-funded students will be evaluated under the same conditions.
